

LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

**Temporary road closure
Station Road, Marys Terrace and Beauchamp Road,
Twickenham**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to maintenance and improvement works at Twickenham Railway Station Marys Terrace, Beauchamp Road, Twickenham and a section of Station Road, Twickenham are required to be CLOSED to all vehicular traffic. The works will involve material deliveries and access to the railway tracks.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Marys Terrace, Beauchamp Road, Twickenham, except for access, and the section of Station Road between Staten Gardens and Clifden Road. During the periods of the road closures, a diversion will be in place in respect of the closure in Station Road and access to Marys Terrace will be permitted via the road barrier at its junction with Railway Approach. These closures will apply on the following dates / times:

Station Road, Twickenham

Oct 2012: 19, 20, 21, 22, 27, 28, & 29

Nov 2012: 3, 4, 5, 18, 19, 23, 24, 25 & 26

Marys Terrace & Beauchamp Road

Oct 2012: 20, 21, 22, 27, 28 & 29

Nov 2012: 18, 19, 24, 25 & 26

3. These temporary road closures were introduced by an Order made under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
4. Nothing in this Notice or the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
