

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

## Temporary road closure Water Lane, Richmond 3 February 2013

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate laying new ducts for cable television and broadband services they intend to make a temporary Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a road closure in Water Lane, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place Water Lane will be closed from its junction with Hill Street to its junction with Richmond Riverside.
- 3. An alternative route for westbound traffic will be via King Street, Richmond Green, Friars Lane and Riverside. An alternative route for eastbound traffic will be via Friars Lane, Richmond Green, Duke Street, Eton Street and Red Lion Street.
- 4. The order will come into effect on Sunday 3 February 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress between 8am and 5.00pm on that day. The order will remain in force for a period of 3 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works, but will only be in operation on Sundays.
- 5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
