ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary waiting restrictions, road closure, Sandy Lane, Vicarage Road

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate essential utility works maintenance and repairs to underground gas mains they have made a temporary Order, the effect of which is to introduce a waiting restrictions, road closure, in Sandy Lane, Vicarage Road
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Sandy Lane between junction of Cedars Road with Sandy Lane and junction of Vicarage Road with Sandy Lane where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
- 3. Whilst Sandy Lane, Vicarage Road is closed, an alternative route for eastbound traffic will be Vicarage Road, , and . An alternative route for westbound traffic will be as above but in the reverse direction.
- 4. The order will come into effect on 14 January 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of 11 weeks, i.e. until . The order will remain in force for a period of 12 months (DEFAULT is 18 months), to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
