

LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary road closure,  
White Hart Lane, Richmond**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to maintenance and repairs to underground drains or sewers they have made an order to introduce road closure, in White Hart Lane Railway Side, Richmond.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to in White Hart Lane from at the junction of White Hart Lane and Railway Side up to its junction with The Terrace . These restrictions will apply at any time and when prescribed traffic signs are displayed.
3. The dates when the restrictions will be in force are from 25<sup>th</sup> January 2013 to 1 March 2013.
4. Traffic will be diverted northbound: via The Terrace, Barnes High Street, Church Road, Rocks Lane, Upper Richmond Road West, Priests Bridge White hart Lane and vice versa for traffic going southbound in the opposite direction. Access to residents will be maintained.

6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform, a police community support officer or a traffic warden.
7. These temporary restrictions were introduced by notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and are being continued in force by order made under section 14(1) of the said Act. The order will remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 5 days, whichever is the shorter.
8. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
9. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
