## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

## **Temporary No Right Turn** Kingston Road, Teddington

(Ref: 13/050)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES 1. NOTICE that to facilitate utility works they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order. the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary right turn ban to traffic travelling southbound along Kingston Road, Teddington.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed to turn right into Fairfax Road from Kingston Road where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
- 3. Whilst access to Fairfax Road is closed, an alternative route for southbound traffic will be Kingston Road, Wick Road, Bushy Park Road, Fairfax Road.
- 4. The order will come into effect on 1 May 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of 3 days i.e. until 3 May 2013. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by 5. prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in (b) uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any (c) emergency.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
