The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on ** *** 201* and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. **) Order 201*.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(**b**) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) for the item numbered 627A in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 1 to that Order the item numbered 627B and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order:

- (a) introduces waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in School Road Avenue, Hampton; and
- (b) extends the existing waiting restrictions in School Road, Hampton Hill.

The waiting restrictions at the junction of School Road and School Road Avenue were shown on a drawing which illustrated the proposals for a batch of similar restrictions in respect of which a notice of proposals was given on 7 December 2012. Due to an oversight, these were not specifically included that notice nor in the proposed order published on the same date. That oversight is now being rectified, and a supplementary notice is being advertised to allow for a proper consultation process.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THIS ORDER

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and these may come from residents, Councillors or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

The Waiting and Loading Restriction Order is intended to improve road safety for all users by introducing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" at the junction of the two roads named above. Similar restrictions have proved effective in locations elsewhere in the borough that previously suffered similar problems.
