





The Council is introducing 'at any time' waiting restrictions in a length of Waldegrave Road.

This scheme is to prevent parked cars from obstructing two way traffic flows and driveways, allowing a free flow of traffic, which will also improve the safety of road users and pedestrians.

This scheme is being introduced on an experimental basis to give the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames powers to make modifications or variations to the scheme in the light of operational experience.

The Council will consider in due course whether to make a permanent Order the effect of which will be to reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of this Order.
