

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Road Closure and Suspension of Parking
FOREST ROAD, KEW**

(Ref: 13/110)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate the replacement of a telegraph pole they have made a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of traffic and temporary suspension of parking in Forest Road, Kew.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to:-
 - (a) proceed in Forest Road between its junctions with Maze Road and Gloucester Road and where relevant signs and/or cones are placed, or
 - (b) wait or stand in Forest Road:-
 - (i) from a point opposite the rear of Nos. 83 and 85 Gloucester Road southwards to a point opposite the north-eastern boundary of No 22 Forest Road or where relevant signs and/or cones are placed;
 - (ii) from a point 10 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Gloucester Road south-westwards for a distance of 30 metres or where relevant signs and/or cones are placed; or
 - (c) wait or stand in Gloucester Road between its junction with Forest Road north-westwards for a distance of 10 metres or where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
3. Whilst Forest Road, Kew is closed, an alternative route for traffic will be via Gloucester Road, Kew Green and Priory Road in both directions.
4. The order will come into effect at 8am on 20 October 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of one day, i.e. until 4pm on 20 October 2013. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
