

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Road Closure
HOLLY ROAD, TWICKENHAM**

**Suspension of One-Way Working
QUEENS ROAD, TWICKENHAM**

(Ref: 13/113)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate street lighting works they are introducing a temporary prohibition of traffic in Holly Road, Twickenham and suspending the one-way working in Queens Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in:-
 - (a) Holly Road, between its junctions with Queens Road and Copthall Gardens; and where relevant signs and/or cones are placed, or,
 - (b) Holly Road, between its junctions with Queens Road and Grosvenor Road, and where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
3. Whilst the works take place the one way working will be temporarily suspended in Queens Road between its junctions with Holly Road and King Street.
4. Whilst Holly Road, Twickenham is closed, an alternative route will be via either;
 - (a) Queens Road, Sherland Road and Copthall Gardens in both directions; or
 - (b) Queens Road and Grosvenor Road in both directions.
5. The temporary measures will come into effect at 9am on 15 September 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of two days, between the hours of 9am to 4pm on Sundays, the 15 and 22 September 2013. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
