

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY
RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) (CHARLIE SHORE REGATTA) ORDER 2013****The Embankment, Twickenham**

- 1 The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to allow for the Charlie Shore Regatta event to take place on the public highway, they have made an Order to give consent for a temporary road closure and temporary suspension of parking affecting part of The Embankment, Twickenham.
- 2 For the period specified in paragraph 3:-
 - (a) no person may drive any vehicle along any part of The Embankment, Twickenham, between the Barmy Arms Public House and its junction with Church Lane; and
 - (b) all parking bays in The Embankment between the Barmy Arms Public House and its junction with Church Lane will be suspended.
- 3 This Order will have effect between 8.30am and 10.00pm on 14 September 2013.
- 4 The prohibitions specified above do not apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden.
- 5 The prohibitions or restrictions specified will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002, as amended **(a)**.
- 6 This Order is given by the Council under the powers conferred by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended **(b)**.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, as amended **(c)**.
