- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 10 September 2013 made the above mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The principal objective of these Orders is to allow an experimental traffic management scheme (introduced on 14 May 2012) to be continued on a permanent basis.
- 3. The general effect of the Free Parking Places for People with Disabilities Order is to make permanent the parking bay (12 metres long) for disabled persons' vehicles operating at any time and located as specified in Schedule 1. The existing disabled persons' bay in this vicinity will be discontinued. The sole effect of this Order is to replicate and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (People with Disabilities) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2012.
- 4. The general effect of the **Loading Places Order** is to make permanent the parking bay for the purpose of loading and unloading only as specified in Schedule 2 to this notice. The maximum permitted stay will be 1 hour. The sole effect of this Order is to replicate and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Loading Places) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2012.
- 5. The general effect of the Free Parking Limited Time Order is to make permanent the limited time free parking places in six streets in Whitton and its adjoining roads. The maximum stay permitted in these bays will be either 30 minutes (for the bays specified in Schedule 3) or 2 hours (for the bays specified in Schedule 4). The sole effect of this Order is to replicate and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (No. 2) Experimental Order 2012.
- 6. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Order** is to make permanent in High Street, Whitton 'at anytime' restrictions as stated in Schedule 5. The sole effect of this Order is to replicate and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the London

Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (No. 2) Experimental Order 2012.

- 7. The Free Parking Place implemented adjacent to No 115 High Street, Whitton is not to continue in operation following reports of congestion. This bay will be therefore removed and the double yellow lines in place, prior to its implementation, reinstated.
- 8. Copies of the Orders which will come into operation on 13 September 2013, plans showing the location and effect of the proposals and the Council's Statement for making the Orders:-
 - (a) can be inspected can be inspected for a period of 6 weeks from the date of this notice, quoting Reference 13/120, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the said Act of 1984 or of any instrument made under the said Act of 1984 has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order continues in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (No. 2) Experimental Order 2012. That Order introduced a loading bay on the west side of High Street, Whitton, outside Nos. 80-84 High Street. Its hours of operation are Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 8.30am and 4.30pm, and there is a maximum stay of 1 hour with no return within one hour. The bay has an overall length of 16 metres and an overall width of 2.7 metres. This is part of a larger scheme which provides additional parking in Whitton High Street.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THE ABOVE ORDERS

In May 2012 the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames introduced a number of free limited time parking bays where the maximum stay is 30 minutes in Constance Road, Tranmere Road and Jubilee Avenue and 2 hours in High Street, Whitton. The opportunity has been taken to identify additional places where single yellow lines may be removed and additional parking places and loading facilities provided without affecting road safety or highway capacity. Apart from the disabled persons parking bay, the new limited-time and loading bays will be in operation between 8.30am and 4.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays.

The Free Parking Place implemented in Bridge Way adjacent to No 115 High Street, Whitton is not to continue in operation following reports of congestion. This bay will be therefore removed and the double yellow lines in place, prior to its implementation, reinstated.

An existing parking bay for blue badge holders on the west side of High Street, Whitton is to be replaced with a longer bay outside Nos. 76-78 High Street, Whitton, to increase the number of free parking facilities for disabled persons.

A new loading bay is being introduced on the west side of High Street, Whitton outside Nos. 80-84 High Street for the benefit of local shops and businesses.

The free parking places will encourage short stay parking in this local shopping area and are intended to boost trading within the borough.

The waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" are being introduced to prevent dangerous parking on the approach to and exit from a pedestrian crossing and to prevent obstructive parking at access points to service roads and off-street parking areas.

The Council has considered the outcome of the experiment and has decided to make the permanent Orders whose titles are given above and which reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the experimental Orders.
