

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Road Closure
HOLLY ROAD AND SCHOOL ROAD AVENUE, HAMPTON HILL**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate works on the copping stone and re-pointing on the railway bridge they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce temporary prohibition of traffic in Holly Road and School Road Avenue, Hampton Hill.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Holly Road and School Road Avenue, Hampton Hill on the railway bridge between the north-westernmost wall of No. 38/40 Holly Road and the south-easternmost wall of No. 16 School Road Avenue or where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
3. Whilst Holly Road and School Road Avenue, Hampton Hill are closed, an alternative route for traffic will be via Holly Road, High Street, Windmill Road, Wolsey Road and School Road Avenue in both directions.
4. The order will come into effect at 9pm on 6 January 2014. The works are anticipated to be in progress overnight between 9pm to 6am for a period of 6 days, i.e. until 11 January 2014. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
