

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure Montague Road, Richmond

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a mobile crane and delivery vehicles they will introduce a temporary road closure in Montague Road, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Montague Road, Richmond, between Onslow Road and Friars Stile Road or where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
- 3. The road closure will come into force between 8am and 5pm on 20 September 2013.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic whilst the works are taking place will be via Onslow Road and Friars Stile Road in both directions.
- 5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 6. The measures described will be introduced by this notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 20 September 2013 and remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 3 days, whichever is the shorter. They may be extended by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this notice or the subsequent order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
