

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure Manor Road, Richmond

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to facilitate essential renewal works they will introduce a road closure in Manor Road, Richmond.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Manor Road between its junctions with Manor Grove and Manor Park. These restrictions will apply at any time and when prescribed traffic signs are displayed.
3. The closure will come into force over night at 00.30am on Sunday, 29 September 2013 until 4.00am on Monday, 30 September 2013.
4. An alternative route for traffic will be via Upper Richmond Road West, Clifford Avenue and Lower Richmond Road in both directions. Access to residents will be maintained.
5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
6. The temporary closure will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 00.30am on Sunday, 29 September 2013 and remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 28 hours, whichever is the shorter.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
