

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Footpath Closure  
Teddington Lock Footbridge, Teddington**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate essential street lighting works to Teddington Lock Footbridge they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a bridge closure at this location.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may be permitted to proceed onto the Teddington Lock Footbridge or where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
3. Whilst the Teddington Lock footbridge is closed, an alternative route for pedestrians will be either Kingston Bridge or Richmond Bridge.
4. The order will come into effect on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of 3 weeks, i.e. until 28<sup>th</sup> March 2013. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
5. The footbridge closure will apply between 9.30am and 3.30pm, Monday to Friday. In exceptional circumstances the Council may agree to the closure being extended on some days.
6. This notice replaces one published on 8 February which is hereby withdrawn.
