

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restrictions**  
**The Green, Twickenham**  
**18 March – 26 April 2013**  
Ref (13/038)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate essential works to a collapsed water main they have made a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to introduce no waiting “at any time” restrictions in The Green (North Side), Twickenham (this is on both sides of the carriageway which a continuation of Staines Road).
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait in The Green from opposite No. 76, The Green to its junction with First Cross Road.
3. An alternative route will be signposted via Sixth Cross Road and Hampton Road as delays will be likely in the locality.
4. The order will come into effect on 18 March 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of 6 weeks, i.e. until 26 April 2013. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
