

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

**Temporary Road Closure
West Hall Road, Kew**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate filming on the public highway they have made a temporary Order, the effect of which is to introduce a road closure in West Hall Road, Kew.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in West Hall Road between a point immediately the south-west of its junction with Brick Farm Close and its north-eastern limit where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
3. As no alternative route for traffic is available, local traffic should not be prevented from gaining access for more than 6 minutes at any one time.
4. The order will come into effect on 26 June 2013. The filming is anticipated to be in progress for a period of 4 days, i.e. until 29 June.
5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the filming;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
