

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Road Closure Manor Road, Richmond 15-19 July 2013

 Further to a notice published on 28 December 2012 The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate track renewal works they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a road closure at the level crossing closure in Manor Road during these dates and times as outlined below.

Date	Times of closure
Monday 15 July / Tuesday 16 July	23.59pm to 6.00am
Tuesday 16 July / Wednesday 17 July	23.59pm to 6.00am
Wednesday 17 July / Thursday 18 July	23.59pm to 6.00am
Thursday 18 July / Friday 19 July	23.59pm to 6.00am

- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Manor Road between its junction with Manor Grove and its junction with Manor Park.
- 3. Whilst Manor Road, Richmond is closed, an alternative route for northbound traffic will be Upper Richmond Road West, Clifford Avenue, (A205) Lower Richmond Road A316. An alternative route for southbound traffic will be as above but in the reverse direction.
- 4. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
