

LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames proposes to construct a flat-topped raised table in the following location -
  - (a) In the service road which connects Percy Road with Broad Lane, Hampton on the south-west side of the junction and which serves a number of shops including "The Rainbow Rooms" hair salon.
2. The raised table will be approximately 25 metres overall length, excluding on/off ramps. The height of the raised table will be 75 millimetres.
