LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary waiting and loading restrictions, The Green (North Side), Twickenham

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to Repairs to the water mains on the highway they will introduce waiting restrictions, loading restrictions, in The Green (North Side), Twickenham.
- Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait or load in a part of The Green, Twickenham. These restrictions will apply from a point opposite No 32 The Green to a point opposite No 48 The Green. They will apply on the side remote from the buildings and adjacent to the public open space.
- 3. The restrictions came into force on 27 July 2013 will remain in force for a further five days until 1 August 2013.
- 4. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 5. The temporary restrictions are introduced by this notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice came into effect on 27 July 2013 and will remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 5 days, whichever is the shorter. This will allow the restrictions to be extended, if the works take longer to complete than was expected
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
