

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Road Closure  
STATION ROAD, TWICKENHAM**

(Ref: 13/091)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate removal of network rail materials from near road side and track they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a Prohibition of Traffic in Station Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Station Road from Staten Gardens to Clifden Road and where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
3. Whilst Station Road, Twickenham is closed, an alternative route for eastbound traffic will be Station Road, Clifden Gardens, Cophall Gardens, Heath Road, A311, Lion Road, Staten Gardens. An alternative route for traffic travelling in the opposite direction westbound will be as above but in the reverse direction.
4. The order will come into effect at 8am on 18<sup>th</sup> August 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of one day, i.e. until 8pm 18<sup>th</sup> August 2013. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
