## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

## Temporary Prohibition of Waiting ROSS ROAD, WHITTON

(Ref: 13/093)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate demolition of property wall of they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary no waiting restrictions in Ross Road, Whitton.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait in Ross Road on the south west side, from its junction with Percy Road to the access gates 1 Ross Road and where relevant signs and/or cones are placed.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 19 August 2013. The works are anticipated to be in progress for a period of 18 days, i.e. until 6 September 2013 The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. The prohibitions will apply between 8am and 8pm Monday to Friday or during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
