## Temporary Prohibition of Traffic CROWN ROAD, KINGS STREET, BEACONSFIELD ROAD TWICKENHAM

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to sewer mains blockage in Crown Road they have made an order to introduce type of road closures in Crown Road with its junction with Kings Street and Beaconsfield Road, Twickenham.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to;
  - (a) proceed in Kings Street from Crown Road and vise versa; or
  - (b) proceed in Beaconsfield Road from Crown Road and vise versa. These restrictions will apply at any time and when prescribed traffic signs are displayed.

The closure will come into force on 1 August 2013. It is anticipated that they will remain in force until 8 August 2013

- 3. An alternative route for traffic travelling along in Kings Street would be to enter and exit via St Margaret's Road and for traffic travelling along Beaconsfield Road traffic will enter and exist via Amyand Park Road. Access to residents will be maintained.
- 4. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform, a police community support officer or a traffic warden.
- 5. These temporary restrictions were introduced by notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and are being continued in force by order made under section 14(1) of the said Act. The order will remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 18 months, whichever is the shorter.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
