- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 1 May 2014 made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order is to:-
 - (a) introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in the lengths of street as specified in Schedule 1 to this notice; and
 - (b) revoke the waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in the length of street as specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

NOTE: The Council has deferred a decision to implement the waiting restrictions in lengths of Campbell Road, Twickenham: ("no waiting 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday") and St Margaret's Road, Twickenham: ("no waiting at any time").

- 3. Copies of the Order, which comes into force on 6 May 2014, plans showing the locations and effect of the Order and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order:-

- (d) Colston Road, East Sheen, the north-west and south-east sides, from a point 3 metres south-west of Nos 2 and 3 Colston Road south-westwards for a distance of 23 metres;
- (e) Garfield Road, Twickenham, the unnamed service road immediately south-east of Twickenham Library;
- (f) Hanworth Road, Hampton, the south-west side, from a point 10 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Nightingale Road northwards for a distance of 35 metres;

- (I) Palmerston Road, Twickenham, from its junction with Whitton Road southwards for a distance of 10 metres (west side) and 12 metres (east side);
- (m) Popes Avenue, Twickenham, from a point 6 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Jordan Mews southwards to a point 6 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Jordan Mews:
- (n) Riverside Drive, Ham, the north side, from a point 14.5 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Locksmeade Road, Ham westwards for a distance of 85 metres;
- (o) Riverside Drive, Ham, the north side from a point 7 metres north-west of a point opposite the north-western wall of No 40 Kingfisher Drive, Ham north-westwards for a distance of 2 metres:
- (p) Riverside Drive, Ham, the south side from a point 8.4 metres north-west of a point opposite the north-western wall of No 40 Kingfisher Drive, Ham north-westwards for a distance of 2 metres:
- (q) Sandy Lane, Petersham, the south side, from a point 19 metres east of its junction with Ham Avenues Path westwards for a distance of 43 metres;
- (r) Trinity Church Road, Barnes, the north and north-east side, from a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 43 and 45 Trinity Church Road south-eastwards for a distance of 14 metres;
- (s) Whitton Road, Twickenham, the south side, from a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 153 and 155 Whitton Road eastwards to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 143 and 145 Whitton Road;
- (t) Wordsworth Road, Hampton, the eastern arm, the west side, from a point 8 metres south of the southern kerb-line of the service road situated between Nos 1 Wordsworth Road and No 64 Rectory Grove northwards to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 1 and 3 Wordsworth Road, and:

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 6 May 2014 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.101) Order 2014.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) for the items numbered 87, 103, 162A, 166, 317, 369, 392, 435, 446, 509, 536, 586A, 623, 719, 791 and 807A in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 1 to that Order the items numbered 822 and 823 and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

introduces waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in lengths of Brunswick Close, Cardigan Road, Colston Road, Hanworth Road, Kew Green, Larches Avenue, Manor Road, May Road, Palmerston Road, Popes Avenue, Riverside Drive, Trinity Church Road, Whitton Road, Wordsworth Road, the access road, off Wordsworth Road, behind Nos 1 to 17 Wordsworth Road and the unnamed service road, off Garfield Road, Twickenham and revokes a length of waiting restriction (no waiting "at any time") in Constance Road, Whitton.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and these may come from residents, councillors, Council officers or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

This Order is intended to improve road safety for all users by introducing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" at the locations contained within the Notice of Making, Traffic Management Order and accompanying drawings. Similar restrictions have proved effective in locations elsewhere in the borough that previously suffered similar problems.

The order also includes the removal of a length of waiting restrictions "at any time" in Constance Road, Whitton where the restrictions are no longer required and may be appropriately returned for parking for the community.
