- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames made the above mentioned Orders on 20 August 2015 under sections 6, 45, 46 and 49 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Free Parking Places Order is to introduce 5 limited time free parking bays in Ham Parade, Richmond Road between Nos. 309 and 319 operating on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 10.00am and 4.30pm with a maximum permitted stay of 30 minutes. Further details are specified in the Schedule to this notice. This Order continues in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (No. 2) Experimental Order 2014.
- 3. The general effect of the **Parking Places Order** is to revoke the pay and display bays in Ham Parade, Richmond Road between Nos. 309 and 319. This Order continues in force indefinitely the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Miscellaneous Streets) (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2014.
- 4. Full details of the Orders, which will come into operation on 24 August 2015, are contained in the following documents:-
 - (a) the Orders;
 - (b) a plan indicating the location and effect of the restrictions; and
 - (c) the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders.
- 5. Copies of the above documents:-

If any person wishes to question the validity of these Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the said Act of 1984 or of any instrument made under the said Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.



- (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Whilst this Order continues in force the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall apply as if there were added to that order a new item numbered 22/2 as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 1 to this order.


STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THE ABOVE ORDERS

Following a review of parking provision in Ham Parade, the Council is introducing a number of free limited time waiting parking spaces. Five existing pay and display parking spaces are being converted to free thirty minute short stay parking places to provide dedicated free turnover parking spaces for the local shops.

The additional free parking places will further encourage short stay parking in this local shopping area and are intended to boost trading within the borough.

This scheme was previously introduced on an experimental basis in February 2014 and these Orders continue in force the provisions of those Orders indefinitely.


