This Order amends certain lengths of yellow line in High Street, Hampton Hill, Stanley Road, East Sheen and Stanley Road, Teddington.

In High Street Hampton Hill, double yellow lines are being introduced across the entrance to Bushey Park opposite Holly Road two lengths of single yellow line are being removed on the south- east side in the vicinities of Park Place and Holly Road.

In Stanley Road, East Sheen, double yellow lines are being introduced across the access road to the car park opposite No 2 Stanley Road.


In Stanley Road, Teddington, a length of double yellow line is being extended south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Sutherland Grove by 2 metres.


STATEMENT OF REASONS


The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and these may come from residents, Councillors, Council officers or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

This Order is intended to improve road safety for all users by introducing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" at the locations contained within the Notice of Making, Traffic Management Order and accompanying drawings. Similar restrictions have proved effective in locations elsewhere in the borough that previously suffered similar problems.

The provisions of the Order also include the removal of a length of waiting restrictions in High Street, Hampton Hill where the restrictions are no longer required.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order amends certain lengths of yellow line in High Street, Hampton Hill, Stanley Road, East Sheen and Stanley Road, Teddington.

In High Street Hampton Hill, it is proposed to introduce double yellow lines across the entrance to Bushy Park opposite Holly Road and to remove two lengths of single yellow lines on the south-east side in the vicinities of Park Place and Holly Road.

In Stanley Road, East Sheen, it is proposed to introduce double yellow lines across the access road to the car park opposite No 2 Stanley Road.

In Stanley Road, Teddington, it is proposed to extend a length of double yellow line southeast of the south-eastern kerb-line of Sutherland Grove by 2 metres.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and these may come from residents, Councillors, Council officers or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

This Order is intended to improve road safety for all users by introducing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" at the locations contained within the Notice of Proposals, Proposed Traffic Management Order and accompanying drawings. Similar restrictions have proved effective in locations elsewhere in the borough that previously suffered similar problems.

The proposals also include the removal of a length of waiting restrictions in High Street, Hampton Hill where the restrictions are no longer required.
