## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporary Road Closure Duke Street and George Street, Richmond

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate manhole cover replacement works they will temporarily restrict vehicular traffic in Duke Street and George Street, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place
  - (a) no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in George Street between its junctions with King Street and Duke Street;
  - (b) no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Duke Street at its junction with Little Green.
- 3. Whilst the road closures are in place, an alternative route for northbound traffic will be via King Street, The Green, Pembroke Villas, Portland Terrace, Little Green, Parkshot, Clarence Street, Kew Road, and The Quadrant.
- 4. The order will come into effect at 7pm on 8 May 2014. The works are anticipated to be in progress between 7pm and 11.59pm on 8 May 2014
- 5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Nothing in this Notice applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 7. The measures described will be introduced by this notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 8 May 2014 and remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 5 days, whichever is the shorter. They may be extended by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
