#### STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THIS ORDER

Under delegated powers an additional parking bay is proposed to be introduced for the exclusive use of Blue Badge holders who meet the criteria approved by the Transport Sub-Committee on 22 July 1996 and for any other vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge issued by a Local Authority.

The bay is situated on Carrington Road, Richmond, outside the side of No 21 Kings Farm Avenue.
