ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure Manor Road, Richmond

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency water main repairs they will introduce a road closure in Manor Road, Richmond.
- Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Manor Road, Richmond from its junction with Manor Gardens to its junction with Manor Park.
- 3. The closure will come into force on 17 July 2014. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic will be via Lower Richmond Road, Clifford Avenue, Upper Richmond Road West, Sheen Road and Manor Road in both directions.
- 5. The provisions of this Notice will not apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 6. The temporary closure will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 08:00 on 17 July 2014 and will remain in force daily between 08.00 and 19,30 until 21 July 2014, that is, for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
