
Temporary Suspension of Bus Lane and Loading Restriction Paradise Road, Richmond

(Reference 14/098)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate deliveries to be made to a construction site they have made a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to suspend a length of bus lane and loading restriction in Paradise Road, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place:-
 - (a) the length of bus lane in Paradise Road, on the south side, from a point opposite Vineyard Passage to the junction with Halford Road shall be suspended;
 - (b) the loading restriction on the south side of Paradise Road from a point opposite the north-eastern flank wall of "The Old Courthouse" to the junction with Halford Road shall be suspended.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 4 August 2014. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 4 August 2014 and take up to 13 months to complete. The provisions of the order will be in force between 9.30am and 3.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and where relevant signs are placed. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. The provisions of the Order shall apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF BUS LANE AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (PARADISE ROAD, RICHMOND) ORDER 2014

Made: 31 July 2014

Comes into operation: 4 August 2014

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the Highway Authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads in the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, are satisfied that a length of bus lane and loading restriction should be suspended in order to facilitate a delivery area to a hotel development site (hereinafter referred to as "the works"):

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

Commencement and citation

 This Order shall come into operation on 4 August 2014 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Suspension of Bus Lane and Loading Restriction) (Paradise Road, Richmond) Order 2014 and shall remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 4 August 2014 until 3 September 2015.

Provisions and Exemptions

- 2. Whilst the works take place, between 9.30am and 3.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive:-
 - (a) the provisions of Item 11 of Schedule 1 to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Reserved Bus Lanes) (Consolidation) Order 2005(b) shall be suspended insofar as they apply to that length of bus lane which is sited on the southern side of Paradise Road, Richmond, from a point opposite Vineyard Passage to the junction with Halford Road; and
 - (b) the provisions of Item 48(b) of Schedule 2 to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c) shall be suspended insofar as they apply to that length of Paradise Road on its southern side from a point opposite the north-eastern flank wall of "The Old Courthouse" to the junction with Halford Road.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle connected with the execution of the said works or to any public service or utility vehicle.

- Nothing in this Order shall apply:-
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, provided that conditions which prevail on site at any one time do not render it unsafe or impossible for such a vehicle or vehicles to use any part of the public highway for the time being.
- 5. The provisions of this Order will only apply during such times when it is necessary to suspend the bus lane and/pr loading restriction in that road or length of road and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(d).
