These Orders introduce lengths of waiting restriction in Petersham Road, Ham and make minor amendments to the parking arrangements in Elm Bank Gardens, Barnes and Mullins Path, Mortlake.

The waiting restriction in Elm Bank Gardens is to facilitate access to a property. The changes in Mullins Path amend a length of parking bay, and the waiting restrictions in Petersham Road, Ham are to assist traffic flow and improve road safety for all road users.

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and these may come from residents, Councillors, Council officers or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.
