

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (SPECIAL EVENTS) (VARIOUS STREET PARTIES) (No. 4) ORDER 2014

(Reference 14/117)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on the 1 September 2014 made the above Order under section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of this Order is to facilitate the holding of street parties on various borough roads to allow residents to celebrate special events within their communities.
3. The streets which will be closed are listed in the Schedule to this notice. Full details of the lengths of each street which will be closed and times when the closure will be in force will be contained in the order referred to in the next paragraph.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (SPECIAL EVENTS) (VARIOUS STREET PARTIES) (No. 4) ORDER 2014

Made: 1 September 2014

Comes into operation: 6 September 2014

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the Highway Authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads in the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, (hereinafter referred to as "the borough roads") are satisfied that vehicular traffic should be restricted in order that street parties may be held on certain parts of the borough roads in celebration of special events as promoted by local community groups:

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 6 September 2014 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Special Events) (Various Street Parties) (No. 4) Order 2014 and shall remain in force until 30 September 2014.

Interpretation

- 2 (1) In this order, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereinafter assigned:-

"police community support officer" shall mean a person who has been so designated as such by the Metropolitan Police Service as provided for by section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002(b) and is wearing an approved uniform as provided for by section 41 of that Act;

"specified day" or "specified days" shall mean the day or days specified in column 2 of any item of the Schedule;

"restricted street" means the street named in column 3 of any item of the Schedule, subject to such limitation as may be specified in column 4 of any such item;

"restricted hours", in relation to any restricted street, means the hours specified in column 5 of any item in the Schedule;

"Schedule" means the schedule to this order.

- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition of Traffic

3. No person may cause any vehicle to proceed in any restricted street on any specified day or specified days during the restricted hours.


Exemptions

- 4 Nothing in this Order shall apply:-
- (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer; or
 - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

Traffic Signs

5. The provisions of this Order will only apply during such times and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(d), as amended.
