EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order revokes the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2012 as a result of the Richmond Adult Community Car Park closing.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Richmond Adult and Community College Car Park will close on 1 October 2014, and the land will no longer be used as a car park. The purpose of this Order is to revoke the civil enforcement and charging provisions which existed on this land.
