

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporary Road Closure Bell Lane, Twickenham

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency works to rectify a voltage fault they will introduce a road closure in Bell Lane, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Bell Lane, Twickenham between its junction with The Embankment and its junction with Church Street. This closure will apply at any time and when prescribed traffic signs are displayed.
3. The closure will come into force on 5 September 2014 at 7.30am. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
4. A diversion route for traffic will be via The Embankment, Wharf Lane, King Street and Church Street.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
6. The temporary closure will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 7.30am on 5 September 2014 and remain in force between 7.30am and 5pm until 9 September 2014, ie for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
