ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure King Stret, Twickenham

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency water main repair works they will introduce a road closure in King Street, Twickenham.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in King Street between Heath Road and its junction with London Road
- 3. The provisions of this Notice will come into force on 7 October 2014. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. A signed diversion route for traffic will be available via adjacent streets.
- 5. The provisions of this Notice will not apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
- 6. The road closure will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 7 October 2014 and will remain in force at all times until 11 October 2014, that is, for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
