- 3. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Order** will be to introduce waiting restrictions as detailed in the Schedule to this Notice,

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order amends certain lengths of yellow line in Grosvenor Road and Holly Road, Twickenham. It upgrades all yellow lines between the junctions of London Road and Queens Road and in Grosvenor Road at its junction with Holly Road to double yellow line ("no waiting at any time").

STATEMENT OF REASONS

These Orders extend the one-way working in Holly Road, Twickenham, provide for a contra flow cycle facility in Holly Road between its junctions with London Road and Queens Road, and introduces "at any time" waiting restrictions in Holly Road between London Road and Grosvenor Road to provide for a clear carriageway for all road users.

Citation and commencement

 This Order shall come into operation on ** **** and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Prescribed Routes, One-way Traffic) (Twickenham Town Centre) (No *) Order 201*.

Interpretation

- 2. (1) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 "the person in charge of any vehicle" means in the case of a motor vehicle the driver of that vehicle and in the case of a pedal cycle the rider of that cycle.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

One-way streets

3. The person in charge of any vehicle entering any road specified in column 2 of any item in the Schedule to this order shall, between the point of its entry therein and the point of its departure there-from, cause that vehicle to follow the direction prescribed in column 3 of that item.

Excepted vehicles

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to the person in charge of any vehicle of a class, if any, specified in column 4 of the relevant item of the Schedule to this order.

Other exceptions

- 5. Nothing in this order shall apply to
 - (a) anything done with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (b) any person who causes or permits any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Revocation

6. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Prescribed Routes, One Way traffic) (Twickenham Town Centre) Order 2014(c), as amended, should have effect as though for the item numbered 1 in Schedule 1 to that Order, there was substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1,2,3, 4 and 5 to the Schedule to this Order.


