

TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTREF NO 14/150ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

Temporary Road Closure High Street, Hampton Slip Road

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to traffic congestion and to facilitate water main repair works, they have introduced a road closure in High Street, Hampton.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit to proceed in the slip road in High Street, Hampton between a point outside No 62 High Street, Hampton and a point outside No 68 High Street, Hampton.
- 3. An alternative route for vehicles will be via High Street, Hampton in a north-easterly direction to its north-eastern junction with High Street.
- 4. The restriction will come into force on 5 November 2014. Further details regarding the dates and times of the suspension are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 5. The provisions of this Notice will not apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 6. The restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 5 November 2014 and will remain in force for a maximum period of 21 days, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs/cones.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
