

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporary Road Closure Upper Grotto Road, Twickenham

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency works to rectify a voltage fault they will introduce a road closure in Upper Grotto Road, Twickenham.
- Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Upper Grotto Road from its junction with Pope's Grove, northwards for a distance of 10 metres.
- 3. The closure will come into force on 13 November 2014 at 7.30am. The works are anticipated to be in progress on 13 November 2014 between 7.30am and 5pm. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic will be available via Pope's Grove .Radnor Road and Upper Grotto Road,
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
     or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 6. The temporary closure will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 7.30am on 13 November 2014 and remain in force until 5pm on 17 November 2014. that is for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
