

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporary Road Closure Castelnau, Barnes

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency works to repair a sewer collapse they have introduced a road closure in Castelnau, Barnes.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Castelnau between its junction with Lonsdale Road and its junction with Washington Road.
3. The closure came into force on 22 November 2014 at 8pm. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 22 November 2014. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
4. An alternative route for traffic will be available via Lonsdale Road, Barnes High Street, Church Road and Castelnau and vice versa.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
6. The temporary closure has been introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice came into effect at 8pm on 22 November 2014 and will remain in force until 7.59pm 26 November 2014. that is for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
