## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

## **Temporary Road Closure Ham Gate Avenue, Ham**

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate water main valve repair works, they have made a Notice to close a length of Ham Gate Avenue, Ham.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person may permit a vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Ham Gate Avenue from the north-western kerb-line of Church Road, Ham north-westwards for a distance of 15 metres.
- 3. The closure came into force on 8 December 2014. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 8 December 2014 until 12 December 2014. The restrictions will be in force between 8am and 7.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive whilst signs are in place. Furthers regarding the dates of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. An alternative route will be available via available via Church Road, Upper Ham Road and Ham Gate Avenue.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 6. The temporary closure has been introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 8 December 2014 and remain in force until 12 December 2014. that is for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
