ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Footpath Closure PRW No 118 – Linking Ham Street and Bridleway No 111 (Ham Avenues)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate resurfacing works, they have made a Notice to close Public Right of Way No 118.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may proceed in Public Right of Way No 118 which links Ham Street and Bridleway No 111 (Ham Avenues).
- 3. The closure came into force on 8 December 2014. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 8 December 2014 until 12 December 2014. Further details regarding the dates of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. An alternative route will be available via Ham Street, Sandy Lane and bridleway No 111 (Ham Avenues).
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used, or person in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 6. The temporary closure has been introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 8 December 2014 and remain in force until 12 December 2014. that is for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
