1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the London Borough of Hounslow, on 26 March 2015 made the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Orders is to:-
  - (a) include in the provisions of the Twickenham Event Days Controlled Parking Zone lengths of Oak Lane and Weavers Close as detailed in the schedule to this Notice;
  - (b) introduce waiting restrictions in lengths of Oak Lane and Weavers Close to operate on Twickenham Stadium Event Days.
3. Copies of the Orders, which come into operation on 6 April 2015, a plan showing the location and effect of the Orders, and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders can be inspected:
