

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporary Road Closure Tower Road, Twickenham

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency utility works they will introduce a road closure in Tower Road, Twickenham.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to enter or exit Tower Road at its junction with Waldegrave Road.
- 3. The closure will come into force on 15 December 2014 at 8am. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 15 December 2014 until 17 December 2014 between 8am and 5pm. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic will be available via Waldgegrave Road and Waldggrave Park and via Cross Deep, Bonser Road and Radnor Road.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 6. The temporary closure will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 8am on 15 December 2014 and remain in force until 5pm on 17 December 2014. that is for a period of 3 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
