

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporay Restrictrion of Traffic in Bus Lane -Eton Street, Richmond

(Reference 14/047)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate urgent utility works they will temporarily restrict vehicular traffic in the bus lane in Eton Street, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person may permit a vehicle including public buses to proceed in the bus lane on the north-eastern side of Eton Street, from a point opposite the north-western flank wall of No 2 Eton Street to its junction with Paradise Road, Richmond.
- 3. The restriction will come into force at 9.30am on 6 April 2014. It is anticipated that the restriction will remain in force until 5pm on that day.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 5. The measures described will be introduced by this notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 6 April 2014 and remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 5 days, whichever is the shorter. They may be extended by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 6. The restriction will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
