ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A


Temporary Road Closure Ranelagh Drive, Twickenham

(Reference 15/010)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate filming on the public highway they have made a temporary Order, the effect of which is to introduce a road closure in Ranelagh Drive, Twickenham.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person may permit a vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Ranelagh Drive between the north-western kerb-line of Martineau Drive and its junction with The Avenue, and The Avenue between its junction with Ranelagh Drive and the north-eastern kerb-line of St Peters Road where relevant signs and/or cones are placed. It will be necessary to close the footway in the area at various times to allow for a cherry picker to operate.
- 3. The order will come into effect at 7am on Tuesday 6 January 2015. The filming is expected to be in progress until 11.59pm on Wednesday 7 January 2015.
- 4. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the filming;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) (SPECIAL EVENT) (RANELAGH DRIVE, TWICKENHAM) ORDER 2015

Made: 2 January 2015

Comes into operation: 6 January 2015

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the traffic authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads within the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, (hereinafter referred to as "the borough roads") is satisfied that an event, the particulars of which are given in Article 2 of the following order, should be held on certain borough roads and that vehicular traffic should be prohibited and parking restricted in order to facilitate the holding of that event and to enable members of the public to watch that event.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and citation

 This Order shall come into operation on 6 January 2015 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Special Event) (Ranelagh Drive, Twickenham) Order 2015 and shall remain in force for two days.

The Event and Interpretation

- 2. (1) The event for which this order makes provision is for filming on the highway.
 - (2) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"restricted hours" means between 7.00am on Tuesday 6 January 2015 and 11.59pm on Wednesday 7 January 2015.

Prohibition or restriction of vehicular traffic

- 3. During the restricted hours, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in the following lengths of street:-
 - (a) Ranelagh Drive, Twickenham between the north-western kerb-line of Martineau Drive and its junction with The Avenue; and
 - (b) The Avenue, Twickenham between its junction with Ranelagh Drive and the north-eastern kerb-line of St Peters Road.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said event or to any utility vehicle.
- 5. Nothing in this order shall apply:
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform, civil enforcement officer, police community support officer
 - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion
- 6. The provisions of this order will only apply during such times when it is necessary or expedient to prohibit or restrict vehicular traffic in the road(s) or length of road(s) specified in Article 3 of this order and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b), as amended.

Alteration of position of/or removal of vehicles

7. Where any vehicle is standing in contravention of the provisions of this order, a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions or he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Contravention

8. If a vehicle is left during the restricted hours without complying with the requirements of this order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty charge notice showing the information required by the Traffic Management Act 2004(c) may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer in accordance with the requirements of the said Act.

Manner of payment of the penalty charge

9. The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council as provided for by Schedule 2 to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Manner of Payment of Penalty Charges) Order 2011(d).
