  - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Traffic Restriction) (Weight Limit) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2013(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:
  - (a) there was added to Article 9 of that Order:-
    - "(g) any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used for that occasion."
  - (b) there was substituted for Item 2 of Schedule 3 to that Order the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule to this Order.


