- (xiii) outside No 19 Wallorton Gardens, East Sheen; and
- (xiv) outside No 30 Watney Road, Mortlake.

and will be in operation at all times.

- 2. The Council is proposing to relocate the following bays:-
 - (a) The bay currently located outside No 1 Grosvenor Avenue, East Sheen to be relocated to outside the eastern side of No. 98 Upper Richmond Road West, East Sheen (bay on Grosvenor Avenue);
 - (b) The bay currently located outside No 3 Leinster Avenue, East Sheen to be relocated to outside No 15 Leinster Avenue
- 4. The Council is proposing to revoke the bats which are located:-
 - (a) outside No 39 Gladstone Avenue, Twickenham
 - (b) outside No 213 Lincoln Avenue, Twickenham.
