



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Waiting Restriction Queens Road, Richmond

(Ref: 15/035)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency tree cutting works they will introduce a temporary waiting restriction in Queens Road, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place between 9.30am and 2.30pm on Tuesday 24 February 2015, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in Queens Road Richmond, on both sides between its junction with Park Road and its junction with Queens Rise (outside Queens Court). The bus stops in this length of road shall also be suspended.
- 3. The restrictions will be in force on 24 February 2015. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on at 9.30am on 24 February 2015 and remain in force for a maximum period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the restrictions will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs and cones.
- Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
