

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure
Sheen Lane, East Sheen
(Reference 15.041)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate emergency barrier repair works on behalf of Network Rail at Mortlake level crossing they will introduce a temporary road closure of the level crossing in Sheen Lane, East Sheen.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Sheen Lane between its junctions with Palmerston Road and Sheen Gate Gardens.
3. Whilst Sheen Lane is closed, an alternative route for traffic will be via Palmerston Road, Temple Sheen Road, Upper Richmond Road West and Sheen Lane.
4. The restrictions will be in force from 11pm on Friday 27 February 2015 until 6am on Saturday 28 February 2015. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on at 11pm on 27 February 2015 and remain in force for a maximum period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the restrictions will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
6. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Nothing in the Notice applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
