

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Road Closure
St Leonard's Road, East Sheen**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency gas works they have introduced a road closure in St Leonard's Road, East Sheen.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in St Leonard's Road from a point outside No. 105 St Leonard's Road to its junction with Clifford Avenue.
3. The closure will come into force on 4 March 2015. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 4 March 2015 for up to 5 days. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
4. An alternative route for traffic will be available via Clifford Avenue, Upper Richmond Road West, Graemesdyke Avenue and St Leonard's Road. Access will be maintained where possible.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
6. The temporary closure has been introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice came into effect on 4 March 2015 and will remain in force until 8 March 2015, that is for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
